Civis4Reform is a national network of volunteer citizen led councils

The first priority is to establish Community Accountability and Transparency Councils (CATCs) in all 338 federal ridings. With CATCs across the land, your voice as a citizen will be heard.

Once councils are established, the first phase of the Action Plan is to begin engaging with our elected representatives. Citizens will play an active role in deciding what is in the best interests of our own communities.

With a revitalized culture of civic engagement, Civis4Reform will introduce CATC assemblies across the country where true debate can take place.

The reform of our political and institutional systems will rightfully place citizens' voices at the centre of the governance of their communities and the country.

Our Purpose

The political party system has failed us. Civic duty and citizen-led engagement is the basis of democracy and the foundation for political reform. The road to reform begins with each of us.
