Actions for Individuals

You need not do everything listed in a given level, but the more the better!

*If there isn't yet an existing local CATC (Community Accountability and Transparency Council) where you live, or nearby, then consider getting one started. There is a separate Guide, available to Civis membership, called **Starting A Community Accountability and Transparency Council (CATC) In Your Area** to explain that process.*

Level 1 Engagement

- A: I endorse the "[Statement of Principles](#)" ("SoP")
- B: I download the logo and include it in my email signature and/or put a decal on my front door/window, my car, my rural mailbox, my work station, etc.
- C: I share the information with others
- D: I wear the T-shirt, fly the flag, wear the hat
- E: I refuse to comply with any unreasonable and unwarranted dictates or mandates from any authorities or their deputies or designates

Level 2

- F: I join a local or nearby CATC group, and show up at events when numbers are needed
- G: I share relevant community information with the group as I hear about it
- H: I share information with individuals in my social circle to let them know about actions and events the CATC is undertaking
- I: I get to know and communicate with elected representative and officials at one or more levels of government

Level 3

- J: I attend most meetings of my local CATC
- K: I help out at most community events
- L: I inform myself on local, provincial, national, and/or international issues that I share with my CATC
- M: I help distribute Civis materials, such as the "SoP"

Level 4

- N: I attend all meetings of my local CATC
- O: I help out in some way at all community events
- P: I join one of our focus groups to get a particular task done

Q: I take courses, attend sessions or conferences, or listen to informative podcasts and videos to inform myself on our rights, our system of governance and our legal system

Level 5

R: I take on a particular role in my CATC (membership, media liaison, outreach, social media, etc.)

S: I help identify and support good candidates for elections at any/all levels (ideally meaning that the candidates support and endorse the “SoP”)

T: I speak up at public council meetings

Level 6

U: I become the leader or facilitator of my local CATC (or both, if that works for you and your group)

V: I become one of the two liaisons (or double-links) to our Provincial/Territorial CATC

Level 7

W: In addition to my CATC work, I take on a role in my Provincial/Territorial CATC

Level 8

X: I become the Provincial/Territorial CATC leader or facilitator

Actions for Groups

Alignment:

I am a member of another group/organization whose goals align with those of Civis4Reform. Our group supports what you are doing, so we are endorsing the “Statement of Principles” both as a group and as individual members of the group.

Affiliation:

The group I belong to wants to go a step further than alignment, so we meet with a Civis member to make plans for a press release indicating that our organizations are affiliated. Now we can use all of your materials and you can use all of ours. Our offerings/materials are included in your “Starting a CATC Guide” resources page. Some of our members join CATCs, Provincial/Territorial CATC, or National CATC. In this way our specialization supports you and we have the benefit of your umbrella organization; together we make bigger waves for positive change.

Joint Events:

Civis4Reform and its affiliates have joint events to further educate themselves and the greater populace and thus regenerate the soil and waters of positive and principled change.

Printing: I own a printshop, am a business owner, or an individual who can contribute toward the cost of printing educational, informational, or promotional materials such as brochures, pamphlets, posters for distribution.

Space: I have access to small/medium/large meeting and/or event spaces.

Time: see Eight (8) Levels of Engagement above; if you have ideas for other means of contributing your time, please get in touch to let us know.

Travel Expenses: I can make monetary donations toward travel for provincial road shows, conferences or similar gatherings, and/or national directors' travel.
